## Footnotes

CENTURY JET, unhurried off the rail, advanced four wide on the turn, dueled for control into the stretch, moved clear nearing the eighth pole and widened slightly under only moderate handling. ZIRLANCELOT settled unhurriedly off the rail, bid nearing the quarter pole then finished well while up late for place. CASTLE QUARTER rated close outside through the backstretch, made a three wide bid for the lead on the turn then dueled close between horses in the upper stretch before yielding the final furlong. SILVER HAT was kept off the pace inside, took aim through the turn, dueled close in the upper stretch then weakened in an outward drift midstretch. OUT IN THE REIGN chased the pace from off the rail and proved empty in the stretch. CHESTER DIGITATION raced clear for the lead inside, was rated through the backstretch, pressured on the turn then gave way in the stretch.
