## **Footnotes**

BERMUDA settled off the pace about the four path, edged closer through the final turn, entered the stretch six wide, dug in for the lead past the eighth pole, was briefly clear then just lasted under steady handling. VALDOSTA, unhurried inside, made up some ground three wide on the final turn, eased toward the outside at the top of the lane and was gaining on the winner every stride. OUT IN THE REIGN rated off the pace in mid track, bid four wide into the final turn, exchanged light contact with Sweet Rascal at the top of the stretch and remained in a close duel to midstretch before leveling off. SWEET RASCAL stalked the pace about the three path, bid near the five sixteenths pole, exchanged light contact with Out In The Reign at the top of the stretch and flattened stride the remainder. REDBOARD KING quickly established the lead to set the pace two deep, was pressured toward the quarter pole and held a slim advantage to midstretch before giving way. WHITE TIE N' TAILS settled off the pace inside, lacked room approaching and through the final turn then leveled off in the lane. TRISTE DOBLE Q, off the pace about the three path, ran evenly through the final turn then weakened in the lane. COUNT THE GOLD pressured the early pace toward the rail and had no further response on the final turn. SUDDENLY SAM, off the pace and off the rail, gave chase toward the seven sixteenths pole then faded into the final turn. FIVE FOR LOVE showed no speed and ran extremely wide on the final turn.
