PATITO FEO showed some early speed then stopped. SQUARE ROOT was outrun then was forced to take up and alter course in early stretch. HOMICIDE was outrun. THIRSTY JERRY was finished early. LIFE IS A JOURNEY was outrun. REAL EXPENSE broke down and fell while in front nearing the final furlong then was humanely destroyed.
