RED MATADOR stalked the pacesetters early, angled wide rallying into the stretch, led briefly then tired. IN NEED OF REIGN raced far back while wide, rallied wide on the final turn and had a mild bid. IT'S SHEER LUCK raced outside, moved closer after a half then faded. KELLERS CHURCH RD. raced far back then rallied mildly. SUNSHINE RONNIE forced the pace to the final turn then came up empty. MR SHAANSHU raced outside and never menaced. SPIDERKID raced inside and weakened. IRISH LADDIE was far back throughout. WITH SPIRIT set the pace to the final turn inside then stopped abruptly. WALDEN POND forced the pace outside to the final turn then gave way.
