
How to Read the Program

Who did he beat? Who had the mount? How fast did they go? What's his breeding? For the answers look to the past performance pages of the track program. It all might look intimidating at first, but this page will show you how to use the wealth of data supplied for each horse.



HORSE DESCRIPTION

- A Horse's name
- B Weight carried by horse including jockey and equipment
- C Program number for wagering purposes (1a, 2b reflect coupled entries)
- D Post position number in starting gate
- E Morning line odds as determined by Oddsmaker
- F Trainer and meet stats
- G Horse's color, gender, age, bloodlines and owner silks
- H State bred symbol
- I Date when horse was born (foaled)
- J Current year race record
- K Previous year race record
- L Lifetime race record
- M Turf lifetime race record

- N Lifetime race record over dirt courses that were labeled other than "fast"
- O Lifetime race record at this distance
- P Race day medication ((L)/Lasix, (L*)/first time lasix, (LX)/coming off Lasix)
- Q Jockey and meet-to-date stats
- R Lifetime stats at this racetrack
- S TRA saddle cloth color
- T Claiming Price
- U Horse Claimed (-c)
- V Denotes claimed from owner, price, trainer
- W Class Rating
- X Breeder
- Y Owner
- Z Lifetime record on this surface

PAST PERFORMANCE DATA

- 1 Date of past performance
- 2 Racetrack abbreviation and race number (Foreign)
- 3 Course condition (see side bar)
- 4 Course symbol (see side bar)
- 5 Distance of race (*/ "about" distance)
- 6 Fractional times of race (in 100ths of a second)
- 7 Final time of race (in 100ths of a second)
- 8 Age group of race (**E** = filly, or fillies and mares)
- 9 Race restrictions (R=Restricted; S=State Bred)
- Type of race & race code(Stakes names are abbreviated) (see side bar)/gross purse in U.S. dollars; Stakes race grade (1.2,3)
- 11 Pace Figure
- 12 Speed Figure (Bold number)
- 13 Post Position
- 14 Start position, or first running position
- 15 Middle running position and margins

- 6 Finish position and margin: ahead of 2nd finisher if winner; behind winner if ran second, etc.
- 17 Jockey's name
- 18 Weight carried by horse including jockey and equipment
- 19 Medication administered race day (B-Bute/L-Lasix)
- 20 Equipment carried by horse (see side bar)
- 21 Equivalent Odds (*-betting favorite) (e-part of entry)
- 2 First three finishing horses, weight carried and their margins **Bold** denotes the horse is in this race
 - Italics denotes the horse won his next start
- Comments regarding race for this horseSize of field (Number of horses in race)
- 25 Layoff line (short/30 days; long/6 months)
- 25 Layon fine (short/50 days; folig/o ii
- 26 Unofficial race indicator
- 27 Morning workouts (b/breezing, h/handily, g/gate, (d)/dogs up)
- 28 7/22= 7th fastest work of 22 works
- 29 Wind direction
- 30 Individual horse time

- · CLM 10/9000N2L (non-winners of two races lifetime)
- · CLM 8/7000N2Y (non-winners of two races in a year)
- ALW 34000N1X (allowance, purse 34,000 non-winners of a race other than maiden, claiming or starter)
- · ALW 34000N\$Y (allowance, purse 34,000 non-winners of specified money in the year)
