

VILLAGE DREAMER took command at once, angled to the inside and gave way in the drive. DUCHWAY was unhurried early, came out four wide on the final turn while moving but failed to sustain her bid in the lane. MIDNIGHT CLASSIC was no factor. FANCY NANC showed speed inside then tired. WHAT'S THE REASON was outrun. LIL RED RENDEZVOUS was outrun.
