SANDTIQUE was rated not far back along the inside, came out three wide midway on the final turn while moving, came in and bumped with DUCHWAY while taking command entering the final furlong then drew out through late stretch. FANCY NANC wasn't far back between rivals, rallied behind the winner into the stretch to gain a striking position then flattened out and held the place. DUCHWAY advanced between rivals on the backstretch, moved two wide to command early on the far turn, came out and bumped with the winner entering the final furlong then weakened. MAGIC REIGN began a run outside on the backstretch, came out four wide to be outside the winner midway on the final turn then weakened in the lane. VILLAGE DREAMER made the pace from the inside to the far turn then stopped. CHOCOLATECHIPCOOKIE stayed inside and failed to menace. LIL RED RENDEZVOUS was outrun. PRIVA'S SPLASH was outrun. LA GRANDE ARMEE steadied in tight before going a furlong, ran out entering the first turn and failed to menace. YEAH ZOOMZOOMZOOM bore out badly while showing speed into the first turn then stopped on the backstretch and was eased.
